This will take place on Saturday, November 7th, from 4-8pm at the Royal Society of Medicine. The substantial illustrated presentation will be given by leading Jungian scholar, Sonu Shamdasani, who has edited the edition. The lecture will be followed by a catered reception with drinks and excellent canapés. The ticket price of £55 is not cheap, but it is reasonable value for what is on offer.

The Philemon Foundation, in collaboration with UK Jungian Organisations, presents a celebration of the publication of C. G. Jung's *Red Book*, originally called *Liber Novus*. This one to one facsimile edition, published by W.W. Norton in the Philemon Series, is edited by Sonu Shamdasani and translated by Mark Kyburz, John Peck and Sonu Shamdasani.

Sonu Shamdasani will present an illustrated lecture, which will be followed by a reception.

Sonu Shamdasani is Philemon Reader in Jung History at the Wellcome Trust Centre for the History of Medicine at University College London. He is the author of *Cult Fictions: C.G. Jung and the Founding of Analytical Psychology* (Routledge, 1998), *Jung and the Making of Modern Psychology: The Dream of a Science* (Cambridge University Press, 2003), *Jung Stripped Bare by his Biographers, Even* (Karnac, 2005), and (with Mikkel Borch-Jacobsen) *Le Dossier Freud: Enquête sur l'histoire de la psychanalyse* (Le Seuil, 2006, Cambridge University Press, forthcoming), and has edited amongst other works, Jung's seminar *The Psychology of Kundalini Yoga* (Bollingen Series, Princeton University Press/Routledge, 1996).
